The **Patient-Driven Payment Model (PDPM)** is a case-mix model focusing on the resident's condition and specific care needs, rather than on the amount of care provided when determining Medicare payment.



PDPM Process Assessment

• PDPM for the IDT: A Team Approach

- Specifically designed for the facility team including: admissions, HIM, MDS, nursing, therapy, social services and billing. The team will gain a better understanding of the MDS process and PDPM reimbursement. Each discipline will understand their role in optimizing payment under PDPM. Through a case study which walks participants from preadmission to billing, the team will learn how to reduce the risk of claim rejection, assure documentation consistency and improve clinical documentation processes.

This advanced, one-day class will prepare participants to return to their SNF with the ability to successfully implement the new payment classification system.



PDPM: Patient-Centered vs. Volume-Based

- Designed to improve the incentives to treat the needs of the whole patient, instead of focusing on the volume of services.
- Reduced overall complexity, as compared to RUG-IV.
- More value-based, unified post-acute care payment system with a focus on patient-centered care.
- Adjusts the SNF per diem payments to reflect varying costs throughout the stay and incorporates safeguards against potential financial incentives to ensure that patients receive care consistent with their unique needs and goals.
